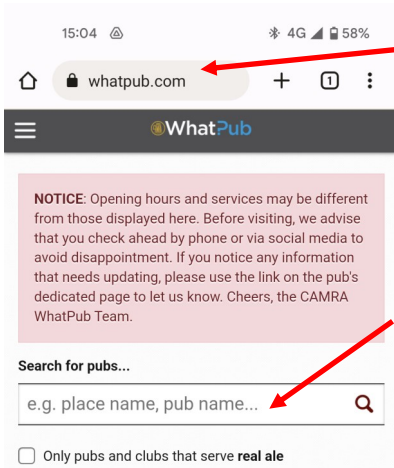


How to score beers on WhatPub

The Campaign for Real Ale's online pub guide

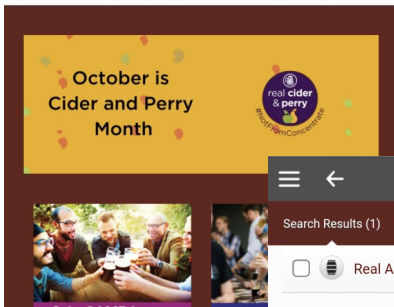


Enter whatpub.com into the address bar on your device

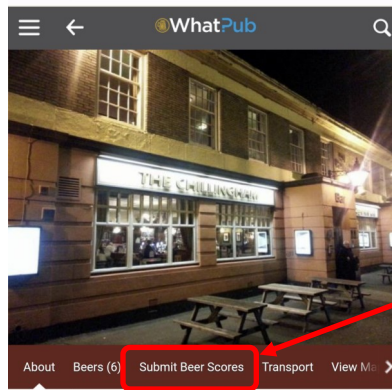
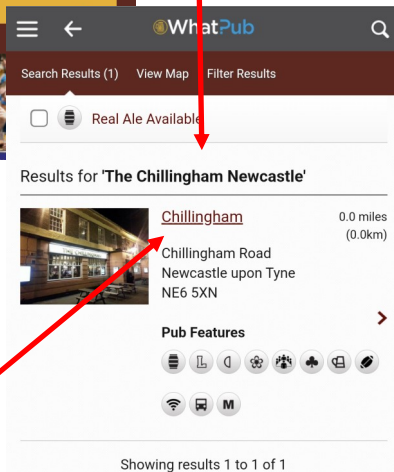

Search for the pub you want to score using the search box on WhatPub.

It can be helpful to include both the pub name and location to help find the right pub



Select the search result for the pub you want to score. In this case the Chillingham



You'll go to the 'About' section which contains information about the pub.

To score, click on 'Submit Beer Scores' to go to that section.

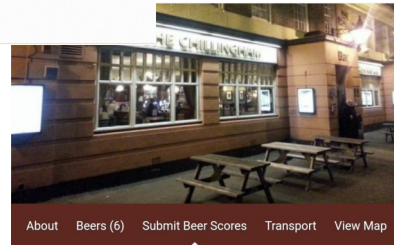

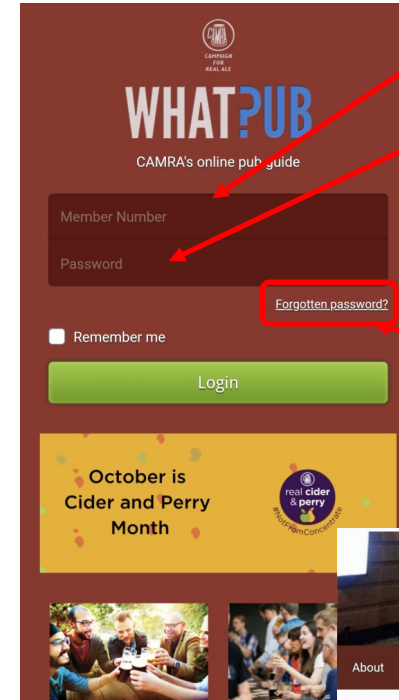
Submit Beer Scores

The National Beer Scoring System has been upgraded and is now fully integrated with whatpub.com, making finding a pub and scoring your beers much easier.

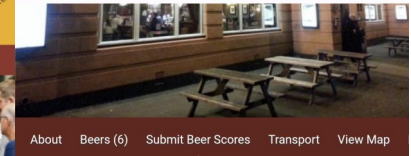


Enter your CAMRA membership number and password. If you've forgotten your password you can reset it by clicking 'Forgotten Password'

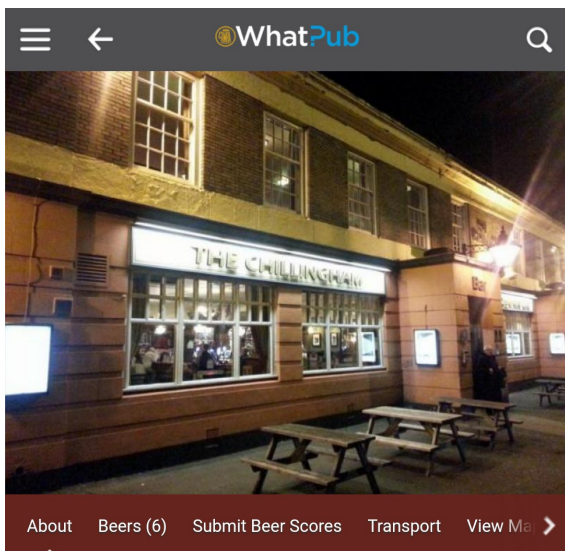

What do the scores mean?

Note: half scores can be given for beers that are between two scoring categories

0. No cask ale available.
1. Poor. Beer that is anything from barely drinkable to drinkable with considerable resentment.
2. Average. Competently kept, drinkable pint but doesn't inspire in any way, not worth moving to another pub but you drink the beer without really noticing.
3. Good. Good beer in good form. You may cancel plans to move to the next pub. You want to stay for another pint and may seek out the beer again.
4. Very Good. Excellent beer in excellent condition.
5. Perfect. Probably the best you are ever likely to find. A seasoned drinker will award this score very rarely.
