Metro: Monkseaton.
Two roomed micropub with an outdoor drinking area to the rear, offering a fantastic range of cask ales and keg ales, always at least one dark ale available.

 **Crafty Wilson** 23 Cauldwell Lane, Monkseaton, **NE25 8SS**
Metro: Monkseaton.
Single room micropub but with lots of seating available. Same owners as Crafty Cold Well, serving four changing real ales and 6 keg lines.


 **Front Street Tap House**
17B Front Street, Monkseaton, **NE25 8AQ**
Metro: Monkseaton.
Micropub with one main room including the bar, with a raised area to the rear and some outdoor seating at the front. Offers four changing real ales and four keg lines. Payment by card only.

 **Nord Bottle Shop**
165-167 Park View, Whitley Bay, **NE26 3RF**
Metro: Monkseaton/Whitley Bay.
Tap room and bottle shop with outdoor seating to the side featuring an excellent range of bottles and craft keg beers.


 **Dog and Rabbit**
36 Park View, Whitley Bay, **NE26 2TH**
Metro: Whitley Bay.
Single room micropub, converted from a women's clothing shop. Corner bar offering six real ales. Winner of North Tyneside Pub of the Year on several occasions.


 **Café Amsterdam**
69 Victoria Terrace, Whitley Bay, **NE26 2QN**
Metro: Whitley Bay.
Single room café bar, following a Dutch style, offering an interesting selection of beers from the Netherlands.


 **Split Chimp**
Unit 1 Ground Floor, Spanish City Dome, Marine Avenue, Whitley Bay, **NE26 1BG**
Metro: Whitley Bay.
Single room micro pub with outdoor seating and fine sea views. Serving a range of three changing real ales alongside the locally brewed house beer Clever Chimp.

 **Hazy Daze**
Unit 3 Ground Floor, Spanish City Dome, Marine Avenue, Whitley Bay, **NE26 1BG**
Metro: Whitley Bay.
Bottle shop and tasting room offering craft keg beers and an excellent bottle selection.


 **The Ticket Office**
Whitley Bay Metro Station.
Metro: Whitley Bay.
Quirky, single room micro pub offering a good range of local craft keg beers, outdoor seating on the platform.

 **Cullercoats Crescent Club**
9 Victoria Crescent, Cullercoats, **NE30 4PN**
Metro: Cullercoats.
Community club with commanding views over Cullercoats Bay from the front bar. Upstairs features sea view lounge and a large concert room. Selection of real ales available in the back room.

 **Tynemouth Social Club**
15/16 Front Street, Tynemouth, **NE30 4DX**
Metro: Tynemouth.
Traditional social club open to the general public, with outdoor seating out front. Offering two cask ales, one of which is usually Grainger Ale from a wood cask.

 **Platform 2 Craft Ale Bar**
Station Terrace, Tynemouth, **NE30 4RE**
Metro: Tynemouth.
Single room micropub situated on Platform 2 of Tynemouth station, offering a range of real ales ciders and craft keg beers. Free vintage style jukebox and occasional live music.

 **Tynemouth Lodge Hotel**
Tynemouth Road, Tynemouth, **NE30 4AA**
Metro: Tynemouth.
Traditional local pub offering a range of cask ales and featuring Draft Bass. It has been under the same ownership for over forty years and been in every edition of the Good Beer Guide since 1983!

 **Flash House Brewery Tap Room**
Unit 1a Northumberland Street, Fish Quay, North Shields, **NE30 1DS**
Metro: Tynemouth/North Shields.
Nestled on a hill overlooking the River Tyne, surrounded by workshops and fishmongers. Tap Room opens Friday and Saturday serving cask and keg beers.

 **Seven Stars Inn**
7 Albion Road, North Shields, **NE30 2RJ**
Metro: North Shields.
Welcoming traditional pub offering five real ales usually from Three Kings Brewery. Single roomed pub with small courtyard to the rear. Bar snacks including scotch eggs, pork pies and meat pies from local butcher.

 **Enigma Tap**
60 Bedford Street, North Shields, **NE29 0AL**
Metro: North Shields.
Single room micro pub with outdoor seating out front and a small patio to the rear offering a selection of four cask ales and craft keg beers.
